- 9) Program: John Smith K3GO: DX and the DXCC award.
 - a) John presented a detailed overview of how contacts are confirmed using either QSL cards mailed back from DX stations abroad or via LOTW (Logbook of the World). John mentioned that he is authorized to verify the authenticity of QSL cards so that the contact may be forwarded on to the ARRL for award processing. He can meet with you and go over your cards. He discussed VOACAP, a program that can be used to predict propagation and your likelihood of being able to contact a particular point on the globe. He also showed his new (used) portable rig that consists of an ICOM 703 controlled via a "Digirig" module that acts as the sound card as well as the PTT controller. The cost of a Digirig is in the range of \$50. They have to be configured for a particular radio or family of radios.
 - b) John opened the floor for questions such as how to reprogram the Digirig and what happens to old contacts with deleted DXCC entities.
