## **PROGRAM:**

Exploring The Florida QSO Party in Expedition Mode (introduction to advanced contesting "Radio Sport")

Presented by Juan Lopez Jr., PhD, AC6ZM and Richard Visman, NN2T

Just the briefest summary of a few high points. We learned about how a small team did their homework on how to make a very good score in a very competitive ham contest that involved operating two mobile/portable (hybrid) stations using specially set up equipment as well as some unique pieces of software and GPS to make as many QSOs from as many places and counties as possible. All of this required careful planning and coordination. Both Juan and Richard are skilled operators, but Juan is unique in that he also does this via high-speed CW which maximizes the number of QSOs and multipliers. They were able to work from several locations that straddled county lines (carefully documented) allowing each QSO to count as two. They used a technique called interleaving where they both operated but never at the same time, so they counted as a single station. Though their stations were mounted in their vehicles, they never operated while moving so that they were counted as a fixed but portable station. This effort required detailed planning, practicing as well as researching the routes ahead of time to find their operating locations. This was contesting at a level most if not all club members were not aware existed.

The program portion of the meeting was adjourned with the 50/50 drawing which was won by Bob Sileo N2PE.
