PROGRAM: Richard Visman and Kevin Pellegrino presented **CQ POTA** a very professional program about Parks on the Air. The program included audio visuals and showed multiple ways that hams can participate. (The following are just some highlights picked up by the writer)

- POTA kind of began as NPOTA in 2016. This was a year long event celebrating the 100th anniversary of the National Park Service. This was jointly sponsored by the National Park Service and the ARRL.
- POTA began in 2018 and is an informal activator sponsored by individuals who maintain websites and databases.
- Activations: To activate a park, you must make at least 10 unique contacts from inside the park exchanging at least your callsign and signal report. The park name or ID number is also desirable but not required. The ten contacts must be on a single **UTC** calendar day.
- Chaser/Hunter: Hams may also make POTA contacts from their own easy chair in the cool comfort of their home shack.
- Park to Park: A bit like an activation but the park numbers must be included in the exchange.
- WARC bands are acceptable as POTA is not a formal contest.
- To have your stats show up online you need to register at <u>www.POTA.app</u> or <u>www.parksontheair.com</u>. (The writer did not get the difference between the two.)
