About Award Accounts

Award accounts are created either automatically as needed or when you create them, depending on the awards program:

- . DXCC Accounts created automatically
- WAS Accounts created by you
- . VUCC Accounts created by you
- <u>CQ WPX</u> Accounts created automatically

automatically created award accounts, when one of your QSOs gets matched (QSLed), a new award account is created if there is not an existing account that can be used.

DXCC Accounts

For DXCC, an account is created for each unique combination of call sign and DXCC Entity. For example, suppose W1AW had uploaded QSOs signed using certificates bearing these call signs and DXCC Entities:

W1AW (USA) 1AW (USA) — old call W1HC (USA) — club call W1AW/0 (USA) — portable operation VE3/W1AW (Canada) — expedition

As matching QSO records (QSLs) were uploaded from other stations, a DXCC award account would be created for each of these cases.

If you have more than one call sign in the same DXCC Entity, you can merge the accounts to make them one. For example, W1AW would probably choose to merge the W1AW (USA), 1AW (USA) and W1AW/0 (USA) accounts into one account. Under DXCC rules W1AW cannot claim credit for QSOs with a club call.

If you have an existing DXCC award, you can have your DXCC record linked to the corresponding LoTW DXCC award account.

Select an award account from the list and click Select DXCC Award Account to get started.

WAS (Worked all States) Accounts

You must create each WAS award account you want to use. The WAS award rules specify that all contacts must be made from stations no two of which may be more than 50 miles apart. (When you apply for a WAS award, you certify that this rule was followed.) All of the QSOs selected for use in a particular WAS award account should be made from a station or stations which follow the rule.

If you wish, you can manually select (in "Your QSOs") the QSOs that will be used in a created WAS award account. This might be appropriate if your operations were from many varied locations. But if you have operated predominantly from one location or a few specific locations, and if you have specified those locations geographically in your station data when signing your LoTW logs, you can set up rules that will tell




